PURPOSE

To define requirements for design change labeling.

STANDARDS

New design level parts must be identified *with a yellow Design Change label marked with design change number for each ECI issued by DMMI. Suppliers are to use the master Design Change Label form (in Forms section) and copy on yellow paper.

Example:



Note: DMMI Material Control will no longer supply adhesive design change labels

Label Placement

One Design Change label per individual box inserted into the AIAG sleeve in front of the AIAG Label.

If the pallet is pure (one part number per pallet/one AIAG tag per pallet) one label is required for the front (the side with the AIAG tag) and one for the back.

If the packaging is returnable, or the part is a pass-through part (a-part), the tag cannot be attached to the box. The design change label should be placed in the sleeve in front of the AIAG tag.
